



NCFE Higher Level Teaching Assistant (HLTA) Status

HLTA status is **recognition of your ability to work at a higher level with increased responsibility**. Working towards this goal is often regarded as a natural progression for experienced support staff within education. HLTA Status is recognised across the UK.

In order to gain HLTA Status staff must be able to demonstrate they meet <u>33 standards</u>. The course will consist of 6, 1/2 day online sessions, run January 2024 through to March 2024, with assessment being completed by the end of June 2024. In order to complete the training and gain HLTA Status you must meet certain criteria:

Entry requirements

• Level 2 qualifications in maths and English or equivalent. If you do not hold the necessary qualifications, access tests are available.

Employment Status

• You must be employed, full or part-time, in a school or educational setting, working with children or young people between the ages of three and nineteen.

Experience

 You must work with individuals and small groups and take whole classes (without a teacher present). You must be fully supported by your school when applying for this programme whether you are school or self-funded.

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Programme costs

Training and Preparation: 180 OMR

Assessment: 220 OMR

Payable on commencement of the programme.
